

Club Championship Information

Updated - April 2022

Dates - held each year over the Civic Long Weekend in August

Men's Flights - Index Criteria

<u>Flights</u>	<u>Index Factors</u>
Championship Flight	up to 5.6
"A" Flight	5.7 – 11.6
"B" Flight	11.7 – 15.9
"C" Flight	16.0 +

**"C" category members with an Index of 5.6 or lower are eligible to participate in Championship Flight.*

***This eligibility criteria also pertains to Intermediate members.*

Women's Flights - Index Criteria

<u>Flights</u>	<u>Index Criteria</u>
Championship Flight	up to 11.0
"A" Flight	11.1 – 21.0
"B" Flight	21.1 +

**"C" category members with an Index of 11.0 or lower are eligible to participate in Championship Flight.*

***This eligibility criteria also pertains to Intermediate members.*

Junior Eligibility - see Policy 1.13 (found on the website)

Competition Details:

This competition consists of two qualifying rounds followed by a cut for all flights, except for the Women's "A" and "B" Flights, who will play 1 round on the Sunday, followed by a final round on the Monday.

The final round for all flights will be on the holiday Monday. Tee Times start at 7:00am. All players will tee off in their flight. Order of play will follow a predetermined schedule which will be published in advance of the event.

Women's "A" and "B" flights, as well as Men's "B" and "C" flights, will use a Stableford scoring format with points criteria established in advance by the Golf Committee.

Both Championship Flights (Women and Men) and Men's "A" Flight will be Stroke Play.

This is a prize fund event with no entry fee required.

Participation in Club Championship Weekend is limited to those that are able to participate based on their playing category restrictions (i.e. "A" and "B" category members).

Male "C" category members who have a handicap factor of 5.6 or lower may choose to play in the Men's Championship Flight for this competition.

Female "C" category members who have a handicap factor of 11.0 or lower may choose to play in the Women's Championship Flight for this competition.

All "C" category members and Intermediate members are eligible to participate in the Weekday Championship that is held in July each year. The final round for the Weekday Championship will take place on the Monday of Championship Weekend along with all the other flights.

Cut Parameters

The parameters outlined below are the same for all flights, including the Women's and Men's Flights, and will be used to determine the cut for the field based on participation rates.

Participants in the Flight

Cut Parameters

Less than 10 participants	- no cut (all participants move on)
10 - 19 participants	- top 8 participants plus ties
20 - 29 participants	- top 12 participants plus ties
30 - 39 participants	- top 16 participants plus ties
40+ participants	- top 20 participants plus ties

Note:

The Club Championship for the A and B Flight Women is currently a 2-day event with the competition not starting until the 2nd day (Sunday). Thus, the A and B Flight women participants will compete over 2 days, with no cut after the first day.

Men's A Flight Cut

- the cut line for the Men's A Flight will be a combination of Gross and Net scores, keeping in mind the above cut parameters with respect to the number of participants that make the cut
- for example, if there are 24 participants in this flight, the players that make up the top 16 Gross AND Net scores will move on to the final round
- the above criteria is in place due to the fact that the scoring for this flight is Stroke Play

****NEW FOR 2022****

- 1) Any player that touched the threshold for eligibility for the Championship Flight (Women - 11.0, Men - 5.6) at any point from the start of the season to the eligibility cut-off for the competition, will be eligible for the competition.
- 2) If a player has met the above criteria, but has a Handicap Index greater than the above values at the time of the eligibility cut-off, they will have the option to move up to Championship Flight or remain in the flight which is representative of their current handicap.
- 3) A player who has won the Men's or Women's Club Championship in the past has a lifetime exemption and will be permitted to play in the Club Championship flight if they choose to do so.
